I. Proposal Name:

Faculty Senate Representation on University Assessment Committee

II. Stated Proposal:

The UCO Faculty needs regular, permanent representation on the University Assessment Committee and that faculty representative should have the same rights as the other members of the committee. The member serving from senate shall be different from the member serving for the college (s).

III. Justification:

The Office of Institutional Assessment provides a wide range of services to Academic and Student Affairs departments and units. Examples of services provided include, but are not limited to the following:

- Collection and maintenance of data on student learning, student self-assessment, and student satisfaction.
- Collection and distribution of data from the Student Perception of Instructional Effectiveness (SPIE) survey.
- Consultation with faculty and professional staff on all matters related to assessment of student learning and student perception.
- Expertise on nationally-normed and locally-developed survey design and data analysis.
- Creation and dispersal of assessment reports to relevant stakeholders.

Anything related to assessment of student learning and student perception should have Faculty Senate input as we are responsible to serve as the voice of the faculty and as the liaisons with administration.
