- II. Stated Resolution: *Be it resolved*** that the following Senators and appointee are confirmed to serve on the Appellate Committee on the Dismissal of Tenured Faculty.

- III. Justification:** Section 2.6.6 of the Faculty Handbook states, "Each university shall institute an Appellate Committee on Dismissal of Tenured Faculty Members. The committee shall not exceed nine (9) tenured faculty members, eight (8) of whom shall be ... elected by the faculty governing body of the university and one member appointed by the president of the university. A quorum shall be five (5) members or a majority of qualified members of the committee. Initially, one half (½) of the elected members shall be elected for twelve (12) months and one (½) shall be elected for twenty-four (24) months; thereafter, one half (½) shall be elected each year. No member may serve more than two (2) consecutive terms. One (1) or more alternate members of the committee shall be elected to serve in the event a regular member is unable to serve."
- According to Faculty Senate records, four past appointees have not been confirmed by the Senate, while four appointees will be newly confirmed.
